**\*Baby Miss, Wee Miss, Tiny Tot Miss and Mini Miss are non-commitment pageants. There is nothing required after the pageant.**

## ***How are baby categories judged?***

*The baby contestants are judged on:*

*Overall Appearance*

*Personality*

*Stage Presence*

*Outfit*

*Smile*

## ***What should baby contestants wear?***

*Baby contestants may wear a dress of your choosing. There are no rules on the attire for the baby contestants.*



***How are Tiny and Little contestants selected?***

*The girls are judged on walk, posture and grace, eye contact, personality, stage presence, and poise when modeling and answering questions.*

***What should Tiny and Little contestants wear?***

*Tiny and Little contestants may wear a short dress which can be a Sunday best. **No floor length please.***



***How are  
Junior  
contestants  
selected?***

The Junior contestants participate in an interview, write a friendly letter as well as compete in the stage portion of the pageant. The friendly letter should include “Why would you be an asset to the Miss CW Court?” The letter should be emailed to [misscwdirector@gmail.com](mailto:misscwdirector@gmail.com) by August 5th.

Junior contestants may wear a dress of their choosing, formals permitted, but not required.



## **How are Miss Contestants chosen?**

The Miss contestants participate in an interview, submit an essay and two reference letters, and compete in the stage portion of the pageant. Essay: Why do you want to be Miss Canal Winchester and how would you serve our community? Email essay to [misscwdirector@gmail.com](mailto:misscwdirector@gmail.com) by August 5th.

## **What should Miss Contestants wear?**

Miss contestants may wear formals or a dress of their choosing.



## *What is required?*

**Christmas in the Village** - we bake cookies for Santa, pass out cookies during the event, and staff a popcorn machine both nights.

**Ring the Bell for Salvation Army, Kroger CW.** (court members serve one hour)

**Downtown Canal Winchester events** such as...Music and in the Park, The Art Stroll, Breakfast with Santa, and other community events as we are asked.

**Fundraisers** - yes they do exist. As a court member, your participation is appreciated. We do try to host events as fundraisers to avoid selling product. IE, Royal Valentine's Ball, Spring Market

**Our court travels to several parades, festivals and luncheons.**

**Easter Egg Hunt - we provide face painting to the younger population of CW.**

**Committees - we have a variety of committees that parents can join to to plan some of our events.**

## What are the expenses?

\$30 registration fee, \$50 pageant sponsor.  
(this can be a local business, family member,  
etc.)

If on the new court:

\$20 tee shirt

\$30 magnets for parades

\$10 embroidery for your daughter's name on  
the back of her sash.

\*this does not apply to our baby contestants.



## ***Required Pre-pageant schedule:***

1. July 31st - Registrations are due, Don't delay, register today!
2. August 5th - Miss contestants, (high school) essays and 2 reference letters are due. These can be emailed to [misscwdirector@gmail.com](mailto:misscwdirector@gmail.com). For Junior contestants, your friendly letter is due and can be emailed to me as well.
3. August 22nd - 10:00 to noon, Meet the Contestants and School Supply Drive at The Prentiss School, 12:00-1:30 Pageant Bootcamp at Hope UMC. (we will provide pizza for lunch) (wear nice shorts, or pants...I will have your contestant tee shirts)



## ***Required Pre-pageant schedule cont'd:***

- 4. August 22nd - Interviews for Junior (6th to 8th grade) and Miss (9th to 12 grade) contestants, held at Hope United Methodist Church. (wear pageant tee shirt and dress pants or a skirt) 1:00-3:00.**
- 5. August 28th - practice at The Canal Winchester Community Center. 5:30 Tiny, 6:00 Little, 6:30 Junior and 6:30 Miss.**
- 6. August 29th - Pageant Day! The baby categories will arrive 15 minutes before their pageant time. Parents will be assist their daughter.**
