The Miss Canal Winchester Community Scholarship Pageant

We are a service organization and provide scholarship opportunities to our high school girls. Our priority is to serve our community when we are asked. We provide girls with the opportunity to develop speaking skills and to increase their confidence.



How are Tiny and Little contestants selected?

The girls are judged on walk, posture and grace, eye contact, personality, stage presence, and poise when modeling and answering questions.

What should Tiny and Little contestants wear?

*Tiny and Little contestants may wear a short dress which can be a Sunday best. **No floor length please.***



***How are
Junior
contestants
selected?***

The Junior contestants participate in an interview, write a friendly letter as well as compete in the stage portion of the pageant. The friendly letter should include “Why would you be an asset to the Miss CW Court?” The letter should be emailed to me by August 5th.

***What should
Junior
contestants
wear?***

Junior contestants may wear a dress of their choosing, formals permitted, but not required.



How are Miss Contestants chosen?

The Miss contestants participate in an interview, submit an essay and two reference letters, and compete in the stage portion of the pageant. Essay: Why do you want to be Miss Canal Winchester and how would you serve our community?

What should Miss Contestants wear?

Miss contestants may wear formals or a dress of their choosing.



What is required?

Christmas in the Village - we bake cookies for Santa, pass out cookies during the event, and staff a popcorn machine both nights.

Ring the Bell for Salvation Army, Kroger CW in partnership with the Lions Club.

Downtown Canal Winchester events such as...Music and Art in the Park, The Art Stroll, The Fall Fest sponsored by the Destination C.W., The Rib Fest, and other commUNITY events as we are asked.

Fundraisers - yes they do exist. As a court member, your participation is required.

Required Pre-pageant schedule:

1. July 31st - Registrations are due, Don't delay, register today!
2. August 5th - Miss contestants, essays and 2 reference letters are due. These can be scanned and emailed to misscwdirector@gmail.com. For Junior contestants, your friendly letter is due and can be emailed to me as well.
3. August 19th - 10:00 to noon, Meet the Contestants and School Supply Drive at The Prentiss School, 12:00-1:30 Pageant Bootcamp at Hope UMC. (we will provide pizza for lunch) (wear nice shorts, or pants...I will have your tee shirts)



Required Pre-pageant schedule cont'd:

4. August 19th - Interviews for Junior and Miss contestants, held at Hope United Methodist Church. (wear pageant tee shirt and dress pants or a skirt) 1:00-3:00.

5. August 24th - practice, location, TBA 5:00 Tiny, 5:30 Little, 6:00 Junior and 6:30 Miss.

6. August 26th - Pageant Day!



Pageant Day Specifics

1. 11:00 Tiny, 12:00 Little, 1:30 Junior, 2:30 Miss Arrive 20 minutes before. Enter through the North side door that faces the tennis courts. Volunteers will help get contestants lined up and ready to go. Contestants must arrive ready for the pageant. There will not be changing rooms available.

August 27th, 6pm, Pictures at the Historical Park (Train Depot)

Saturday, 9/2 - Introductions to the community on the main stage. 12:00 noon

Saturday 9/2 - Lemonade Social, 12:30-1:30 pm InterUrban building, behind Stradley Park facing the green space.

Sunday 9/3 - Historical Society Ice Cream Social. 2-4:00pm

Monday, 9/4 - Queens Breakfast, CW High School, parade
